DANCE GUIDELINES

Procedure

- Students will enter the dance upon arrival and leave immediately at the end of the dance. Students are not permitted to loiter in the parking lot or in parked cars at the dance location. Students who need to leave the dance location for any reason must receive permission from the chaperones.
- Parents will be notified if students arrive late (more than an hour) to the dance or leave early from the dance (more than an hour).
- If students leave the dance early, they will not be permitted to return. If students leave the dance without permission, consequences will be given.
- Only high school students of the school and their approved guests are allowed in the dance. Students will present tickets and the guest may be asked to show a student ID.

Dress Code

- Students will be expected to abide by the dress code as outlined in the Parent-Student Handbook. All the same guidelines for modesty and appropriateness apply at all EHCS Dances. Girls who arrive in dresses or outfits that were not pre-approved will not be admitted.
- Boys who dress inappropriately for the dance will not be admitted.
- **Sadies Dance:** Outfits will not need to be checked, but students will be held accountable for modesty and appropriateness.
- **Homecoming Dance/ Jr-Sr Prom:** Female students are expected to wear formal evening attire that includes a dress and appropriate shoes. The hemline, including slits, for formal dresses must be no shorter than fingertip length when standing. Tops and dresses (a) must not be see-through or form-fitting, (b) must not expose cleavage or midriff skin with arms raised either sitting or standing, and (c) must not be backless or have cut-outs below the bra line in the back. Female students may not wear casual attire, but athletic shoes which are clean and intended as part of the outfit are acceptable. Male students are expected to wear formal evening attire that includes a suit with a tie or sport coat and slacks with a tie and appropriate shoes. Male students may not wear casual attire, including, without limitation, blue jeans, flip flops, sandals, or similar footwear to any formal events. Attire with subtle prints is permitted; however, formal attire may not include cartoons or logos.

Behavior

- Dancers will be expected to face each other and hands will be kept in only appropriate places of the opposite gender.
- Any inappropriate or sexually suggestive dancing will be addressed by the chaperone. For any repeated offenses, parents will be notified and students will risk being removed and possible further school discipline will be administered.
- Since alcohol and drugs are prohibited at EHCS (expulsion offense), any attendee suspected of being in possession of, under the influence of, or distributing alcohol or drugs, will not be permitted to enter the dance, and the proper authorities notified. EHCS students will be subject to disciplinary action up to and including expulsion from school.
