Tuition Payment Plan Options

<i>Annual Payment</i>	<i>\$9,750 - Due June 1, 2025</i>
<i>Semi-Annual Payment</i>	<i>\$4,875 - Due June 1, 2025 December 1, 2025</i>
<i>Quarterly Payment</i>	<i>\$2,437.50 - Due June 1, 2025 September 1, 2025 December 1, 2025 March 1, 2026</i>
<i>10 Month Payment Plan</i>	<i>\$975 - 10 equal installments from August 1, 2025 to May 1, 2026</i>
<i>12 Month Payment Plan</i>	<i>\$812.50 - 12 equal installments from June 1, 2025 to May 1, 2026</i>

Scholarships

Multi-student scholarships of up to \$240 are available for students in the same family billing account for the third child and beyond.

Scholarships accepted including AAA, Facts Grant Aid, Step Up for Students FTC, FES-EO, and FES-UA. Scholarship amount will be applied to tuition. The family is financially responsible for any remaining balance of tuition or additional fees.

Financial aid beyond state-sponsored scholarships is available on a limited basis. Contact Deb Hawkins for instructions to apply.

Returning Student Fees

EHCS offers continuous enrollment contracts, which means that once enrolled, students are automatically re-enrolled each year until graduation or until the parent informs the school otherwise.

Continuous enrollment contracts may be canceled in January of each year without penalty. To terminate this Enrollment Agreement, the Parent/Guardian must notify the Admissions Office by submitting the Opt Out/Withdraw Form by January 31st of the current school year. Parent/Guardian acknowledges that the tuition and fees charged for the academic year are for an enrollment place within EHCS and not for a specified period of attendance. Accordingly, the absence of a student during that academic year does not materially reduce the expenses of EHCS. Parent/Guardian agrees that the absence, academic failure, or withdrawal of the student during the academic year shall not excuse, alter, abate, or nullify the parent's/guardian's obligations for payment of tuition and certain other charges and fees through the academic year.

<i>Lunch</i>	<i>Lunches are available and billed directly through a third-party vendor</i>
<i>PE Uniforms</i>	<i>Students in grades 6-12 must purchase a PE uniform if a PE class is on their schedule. Uniforms will be available through the school office.</i>
<i>Club Dues</i>	<i>Some clubs and/or extra-curricular activities may include a fee</i>
<i>Field Trips</i>	<i>Fees will be communicated through the sponsoring teacher and billed as an incidental fee</i>
<i>Aftercare</i>	<i>\$25 - \$65 weekly per student depending on the number of days</i>
